DISASTER ASSISTANCE RESPONSE TEAM

Our Disaster Assistance Response Team (DART) provides relief to victims of disaster worldwide, offering water, food, shelter and medical care. DART members are trained, specialised professionals who stand ready to respond at a moment's notice whenever and wherever disaster strikes, and no matter where they go, they always go in the Name of Jesus Christ.





We have responded to devastating earthquakes in Haiti, Ecuador, and Nepal; typhoons in the Philippines; and to large-scale refugee crises in Europe, the Middle East, and Africa. We have sent teams to fight infectious diseases such as Ebola in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and diphtheria in Bangladesh. We deployed our Emergency Field Hospital to both Cremona, Italy, and New York City during the COVID-19 pandemic. We also deployed our field hospital to the Bahamas after Hurricane Dorian.
